The GenED™* platform enables 21st century learning and collaboration whilst building a comprehensive picture of student learning over time. It connects students, teachers and parents by providing relevant, real-time student feedback and reporting. It also provides access to shared content and high quality curriculum resources.

GenED is a safe and secure online platform. There is no infrastructure to manage and all services are offered on a simple per-student subscription basis. It is supported by a full-time help

desk and access to quality professional development. Integrating the platform with existing systems is easy and support is provided every step of the way.

GenED is the result of a multi-year partnership between the Victorian Department of Education and Early Childhood Development and NEC. Starting its journey as the Ultranet in 2010, GenED has evolved into a robust, fully managed and hosted platform.

NEC GenED product features:

LEARNING TASKS – a learning management system where teachers can plan, deliver and assess learning activities, and students can view and participate in learning activities. Parents can also view student activities and feedback.

LEARNER PROFILE – a space where students, their parents and teachers can view a detailed profile of individual learning progress and attendance.

EXPRESS SPACE – a personal space for students and teachers to capture, share and reflect upon their learning. Includes spaces for Student Learning Portfolio and Learning Goals.

COLLABORATIVE SPACES – spaces rich in Web 2.0 functionality where users can communicate and collaborate. Communities may be private, restricted or open and be set up within and across schools.

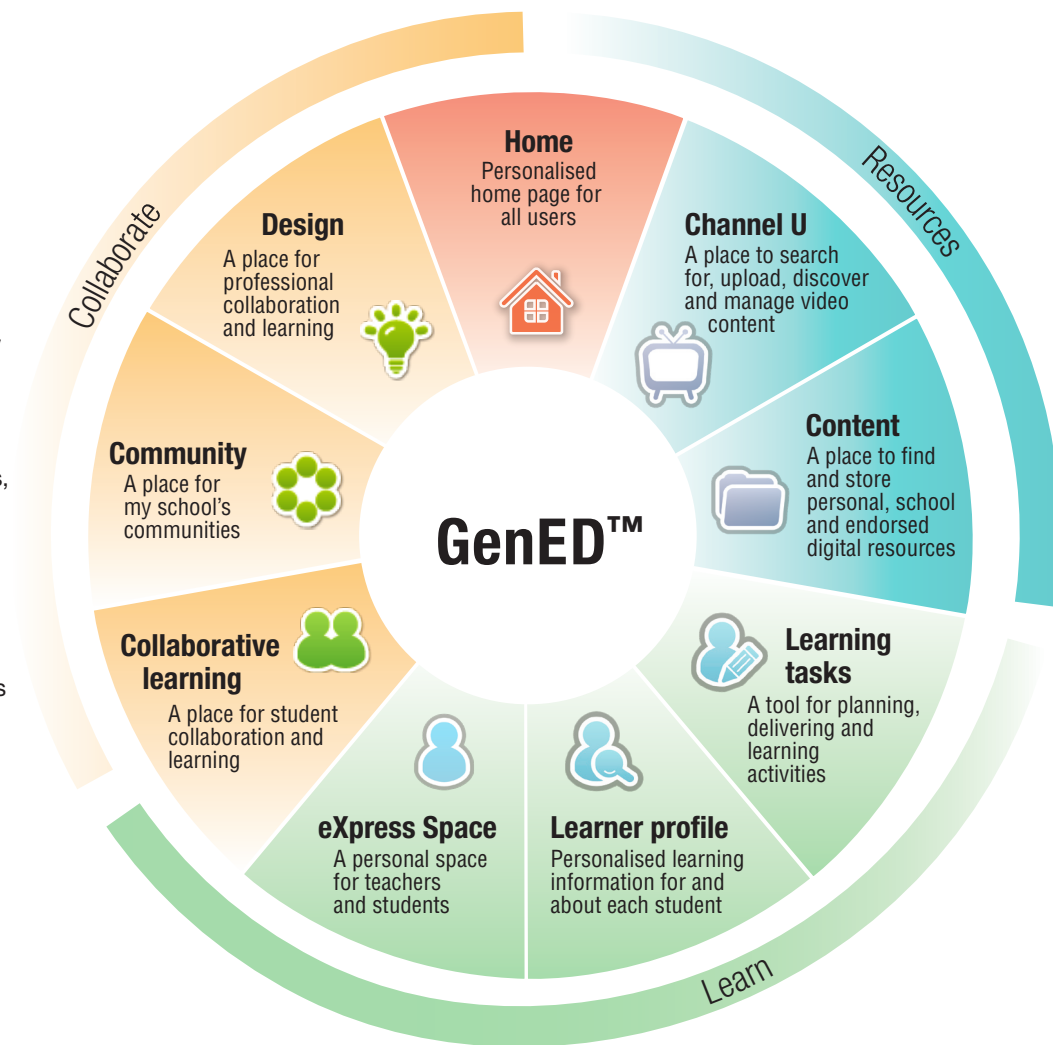
DESIGN – a space where teachers can plan, create and collaborate with colleagues within and across schools. Teachers can use this space to design curriculum and student learning activities.

COLLABORATIVE LEARNING – a space where students can take part in collaborative learning activities set up by their teachers. Students can also set up their own spaces.

COMMUNITY – a space where students, parents and teachers can find the latest school news and events and get involved in school-based groups, clubs or activities.

CONTENT – a repository where teachers and students can store and search for personal, school and quality-assured digital learning resources.

CHANNEL U – a repository that allows users to collaborate and share created visual and audio to create a powerful communication tool.



Other features:

- Timetable and attendance will be tightly integrated with GenED so that timetable and attendance marking performed within First Class will be quickly available for viewing via the interface.
- Data loading portal – student, school, teacher, student contact information will be uploaded into GenED via agreed format CSV files. Changes can be made to the CSV file data immediately and only the changed information will be processed.
