UEDUCATEUS ANNOUNCEMENTS

A test announcement has been sent today for you to check your phone is working correctly.

HEAD LICE CHECKS

Over the last couple of weeks we have had a quite a number of students with head lice so we have decided to have a whole school check on Tuesday 23rd February.

As per our School Head Lice Policy any student found with live lice, parents/ guardians will be contacted and sent home immediately with an 'action taken' notice. Parents/ guardians will need to treat the lice and complete the bottom section of the notice and return this section with the student the following day. Staff will check returning students to see if they are lice free. If there are still live lice present the process will start again.

If students are found to only have eggs, but no live lice the same 'action taken' notice will be sent home with the student. Parents/ guardians will need to treat the eggs and complete the bottom section of the notice and return this note with the student the following day. Staff will check returning students over the next couple of days to ensure no live lice are present. If live lice are present the students will be sent home and the above process implemented.

When live lice or eggs are found on a student a red Head Lice Alert will be sent home to all children within that learning hub notifying you of the situation. Please ensure you check your child/ren when this note is brought home and notify the office staff if you find live lice or eggs.

Head Lice management needs to be a whole school community process and we thank you for your support in implementing our head lice elimination procedures. If any parents would like a copy of our Head Lice Policy please contact office staff.
