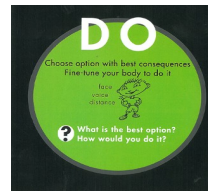
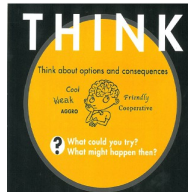
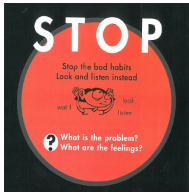
MORWELL CENTRAL INTERIM SCHOOL COUNCIL MEETING
