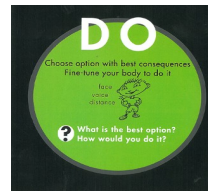
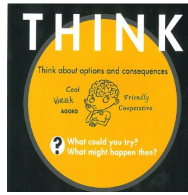
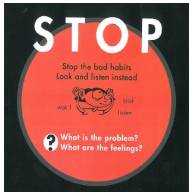
END OF TERM
