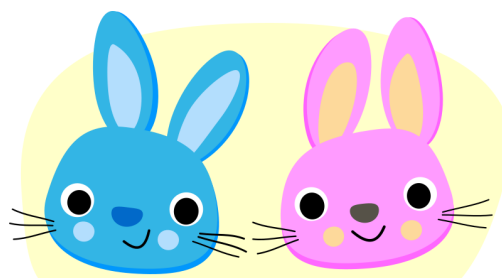

### TERM 1 STUDENT PROGRESS REPORTS

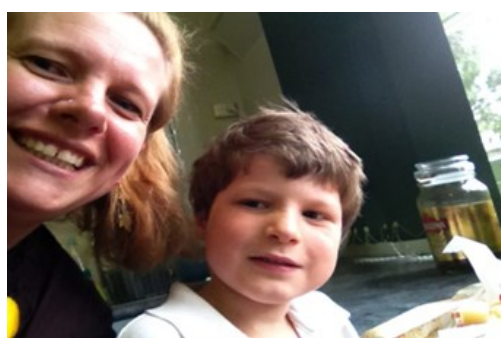

### SCARF REWARDS

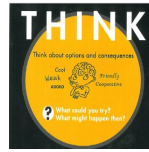
